


CITY ORDINANCE NO. 0-80-2

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING AN AD VALOREM TAX FOR THE SUPPORT OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF THE CITY OF SOMERSET, TEXAS, FIXING THE TAX RATE AT TWO DOLLARS FIFTY CENTS PER ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS VALUATION, ALL OF SAID TAXES BEING LEVIED FOR THE TAX YEAR BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 1981, AND ENDING DECEMBER 31, 1981.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOMERSET, TEXAS:

There is hereby levied for general purposes, for the tax year beginning January 1, 1981, and ending December 31, 1981, on all property, real, personal and mixed, within the corporate limits of the City of Somerset, Texas, not otherwise exempted by the Constitution and laws of the State of Texas and ordinances of the City of Somerset, Texas, an ad valorem tax of and at the rate of Two Dollars Fifty Cents (\$2.50) upon each One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) of assessed valuation.
